After receiving your submission, the LAIMUN staff will work to meet your requests and respond with your delegates' final assignments. We will do our best to fulfill your country preferences **but do not guarantee we will be able to accommodate your requests. If you wish to obtain additional nations to represent, please do not hesitate to contact us so that we may meet your needs.**

This year's fee will be **\$20.00** per novice delegate, and **\$40.00** per advanced delegate, with no school fee. Please make checks payable to MBX and sent to Mira Costa High School to the attention of MCHS MUN/LAIMUN/Bob Timberlake. We ask that **all delegate fees be paid prior to the conference** so that we do not have problems with late checks nor inconveniences on the day of the conference. Your compliance is greatly appreciated.

At LAIMUN, we value accurate policy and practical solutions above all else. Competing delegates will be judged on their knowledge and ability to accurately represent the policy and actions of their assigned countries. We would encourage delegates to demonstrate an understanding of their country policy and the reality of their solutions through their speaking and caucusing abilities.
